Grant Recipient: Montville Township **Location:** Montville Twp.

The Montville Schoolhouse, built about 1867, is individually eligible for listing in the New Jersey and National Registers of Historic Places for local significance as a building associated with one of the important 19th-century functions of the village of Montville, and as a well-preserved example of a post-Civil War one-room schoolhouse.

The 2005 construction grant provided for an ADA ramp. A separate non-construction grant will provide for the preparation of a nomination of the Schoolhouse to the New Jersey Register of Historic Places.

The 2007 grant provided for exterior restoration including the cupola.

The 2008 grant assisted with the repair of masonry walls and chimney; restoration and repainting of interior walls, windows, doors, trim and interior; electrical upgrade, and associated architectural construction administration and paint analysis fees.
