Acorn Hall was constructed as an Italianate residence in 1853 and expanded in 1860. The building is individually listed on the National and New Jersey Registers. The Carriage House is representative of a mid-19th C., upper middle-class, utilitarian carriage house.

The 2018 grant provided for the preparation of Construction Documents for roof restoration and stabilization of building structure.

The 2019 grant assisted with Phase I Restoration including stabilization of the building structure, restoration of roof, exterior woodwork, and restoration of cupola. A separate grant provided for Construction Documents related to exterior restoration and interior rehabilitation.

The 2020 grant provided for Phase II Rehabilitation.

The 2021 grant is assisting with interior restoration including electrical update, alarm system, reinstallation and restoration of original wall and ceiling finishes, and restoration of wood trim.
