Location: Morristown Town

Buildings located at 57 E. Park Place: The Romanesque Revival Sanctuary with Tiffany panels and the 1869 Chapel are used for church services, concerts, most open to the public. Howard House (the manse) was built 1885 as the minister's residence. The 1878 Parish House, at 65 South St., provide offices, classrooms, dining hall, used by the parishioners and public.

The 2010 grant completed a Historic Site Master Plan for the Chapel, Manse, Parish House and Sanctuary.

The 2011 and 2012 Construction grants assisted with the stabilization of the chimney at Howard House, stabilization and work with the chimney at the rear of the Parish House, vestry roof, and the Church Building air shaft.

The 2013 grant provided for the restoration of the Chapel slate roof, flat roof, gutters and downspouts, work associated with the parapets, also brick piers at basement and provide additional structural support.

The 2025 grant assisted with exterior restoration including tower masonry repointing, hyphen reroofing and chapel gable-end louvers restoration.
