The Schuyler-Hamilton House, also known as Dr. Jabez Campfield House, is significant for its association with Alexander Hamilton, as the place where he courted Betsy Schuyler, during the winter of 1779-80 when the Continental Army was at Jockey Hollow. The house is now individually listed on the New Jersey Register of Historic Places.

The 2005 grant provided for the preparation of a Preservation Plan and Historic Register nomination.

The 2006 grant addressed structural repairs and roof work.

The DAR Morristown Chapter completed the reroofing of the rear porch, interior plaster restoration, exterior painting and framing assessment with a 2009 grant.

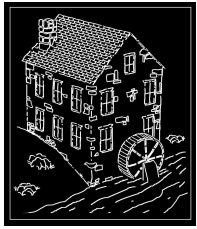
A 2013 grant repaired interior finishes and upgraded existing electrical and plumbing systems.

The 2019 grant assisted with preparation of an Amendment of the 2006 Preservation Plan including site and landscape evaluation, building systems assessment, use and interpretation, code and accessibility, and maintenance plan.

The 2020 grant completed construction documents related to exterior restoration and rehabilitation including window and siding restoration, and painting.

The 2021 grant provided for exterior restoration and rehabilitation including restoration of windows.

The 2022 grant assisted with exterior repair including repair of exterior siding and trim, replacement of basement bulkhead doors, exterior painting.
