Stone Arch Bridge

Location: Boonton Town

The 1866 Stone Arch Bridge served as a viaduct to provide fire protection for the Boonton Ironworks. The Bridge is the only intact portion of the ironworks remaining. It now functions as a walking bridge and overlook for the Boonton waterfalls and is the only connection across the Rockaway River from the Grace Lord Park to the ironworks. The Bridge is individually listed on the New Jersey and National Registers of Historic Places.

The 2018 grant completed a Conditions Assessment.

The 2019 grant completed Construction Documents for \$761,700 of construction work related to the preservation and stabilization of the structure, landscape and architecture design.

The 2020 grant will provide for stabilization and repair of the masonry structure including stone cleaning, raking and repointing of mortar, and replacement of concrete bridge deck.
