Grant Recipient: Pequannock Township

Location: Pequannock Twp.

The Pompton Plains Passenger Station was integral to the development of Pequannock Township. It is one of the few surviving late 19th century stations typifying such structures before the expansion of the railroads in the early 20th century. The Station has been determined to be eligible for listing on the New Jersey Register of Historic Places.

The 2005 grant assisted with the acquisition of the Station by the Township of Pequannock, which provided matching funds of \$75,000 for a total acquisition cost of \$150,000.

The 2006 and 2007 grants provided for interior and exterior restorations, including foundation repairs; roof repairs and restoration; wood floor replacement and refinishing; installation of an appropriate wood platform; ADA accessibility and restroom; site restoration; restoration of windows and doors; installation of period lighting; and lighting, electrical and plumbing upgrades.

The 2021 grant completed a Preservation Plan including recommendations for use.

The 2022 grant completed Construction Documents related to new slate roofing, brick chimney restoration, exterior woodwork restoration and painting.

The 2023 grant will assist with exterior rehabilitation including roof replacement, millwork restoration, doors, and windows.
